

Transfusion Acquired Infections:

Regulatory Guidelines require the reporting of any transfusion acquired infections. This has become very rare since the advent of nucleic acid testing. Infections that may be transmissible by transfusion include HIV, Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C, HTLV I/II, Syphilis, Cytomegalovirus (CMV), Malaria, Babesiosis, Chagas' Disease, Toxoplasmosis, Lyme Disease and West Nile Virus.

All Suspected cases of post-transfusion transmitted diseases, any unexplained acute liver dysfunction occurring within 2 weeks to 12 months after transfusion, or any complication or potential adverse reaction following transfusion should be reported to Bronson Hospital Blood Bank Departments at:
